

Tax records for Warrior's Mark Township, Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania.

Notes at the beginning of microfilm state the following:

Franklin Township 1790-1833

Warriors Mark Township 1798 1833

Morris Township 1795- 1833

Franklin township was removed from Tyrone in 1789 and taxed separately in 1790. Warriors mark area records re included with Tyrone until 1798, and Morris Tonwship records will be found with those of Tyrone Township until 1795. In that year, Morris, including present Catharine Township of Blair county, was made an independent district.

I originally planned to look for Lees, Sacketts, and Thompson. But I came across the Masterson name. One of Robert Lee's (d. 1803) daughters was married to a Masterson. I've thought that there might be a connection with the Thompson family because of the names of one of James Lee's sons (Jefferson T. Lee), so even though I don't now with any certainty that there is a connection, I collected the Thompson tax info. Then I found that there was a John McCullough who, I believe, was the name of the son of one of the Lee daughters of Robert (d. 1803). Because of Baughman connections in Jefferson County, I also started collecting that information when I saw it (I may have missed earlier Baughman, Masterson, and McCullough information because I wasn't originally looking for those names.) For many years, a Samuel McGaw was listed in the "unseated lands."
